tour to meet the characters, walk the streets, and see the buildings where this great drama played out.

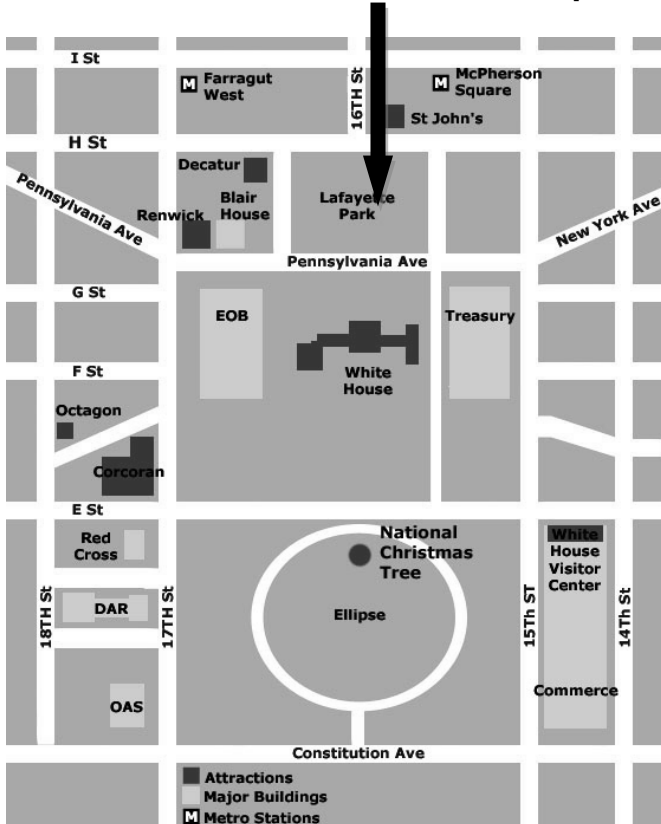
**Duration:** Approximately 2 hours.
